Prince George's County Portion of Riderwood

The two best methods for reaching all your elected officials are by e-mail and phone. Many officials, especially in the U.S. Congress, use web-based e-mail rather than standard e-mail addresses, so use the web links shown below for them. Sending letters using snail-mail is still possible, but far less effective.

You may be interested in contacting Members of Congress who represent states and districts other than where you live, particularly the leaders of both parties in both chambers. If so, go right ahead. But keep in mind that these officials are far less likely to heed your input if they are aware that you are not a constituent. Indeed, many members of Congress block input from those who are not constituents by setting their web-based e-mail so that it will not accept messages from anyone not providing a residential address in their state/district. (Some people who want to get a message to Members of Congress who do not represent them place calls late at night and leave a voice mail, but there is no assurance that such voicemails have an impact). The main switchboard number to reach any U.S. Senate office is 202-224-3121, and to reach any U.S. House office, 202-225-3121.

Special note – Many Riderwood residents on the Prince George's County side have been sorely vexed in attempting to convey their views to Rep. Anthony Brown, who is indeed their representative. Apparently his staff members are using software that incorrectly identifies the district boundaries, erroneously indicating that people at Riderwood do not live in his district. Anyone who persuades his staff to fix this problem will be doing a great service to us all.
