


Flensburg – Navy Officers School Mürwick

The Kiel Canal (in German: Nord-Ostsee-Kanal) which connects the Northern Sea (Nordsee) with The Baltic Sea (Ostsee).

It was finished in 1914 and it is about 100 Km (61 M) long.

- The tide here is only about a foot compared to the western lock with a tide of about 12 foot.
- The canal is rather narrow. Here a place in Holtenau where 2 bigger ships can pass each other.



Freie und Hansestadt Bremen (Free and Hanse-City of Bremen)

- **Hanseatic League: commercial and defensive association of cities in the Baltic, Netherlands, and Belgium.**
- **Goes back to about 1350.**
- **Bremen is 1 of 3 City States in Germany (others are Berlin and Hamburg)**
- **Bremerhaven belongs to Bremen and is the Atlantic port of Bremen.**








