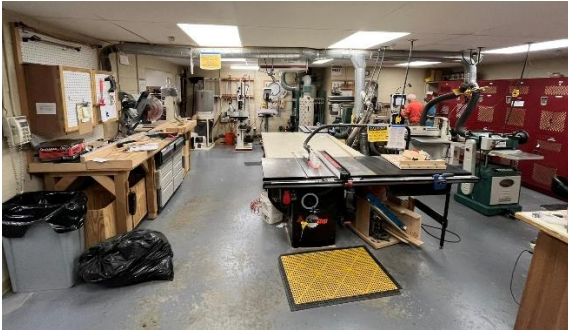




The Wood Shop is in the Montgomery Station Neighborhood.

It is on the Terrace Level of Charles Terrace, opposite Room CT-T08



The first room contains stationary power tools



On the right side of the room are Belt and Disc Sanders, a Surface Planer, Jointer, a Radial Drill Press and a Router Table.

In the background are Storage Lockers for use by members.



On the left is a Compound Miter Saw.

In the center is a “Saw Stop” Table Saw, which detects body contact with the blade and stops instantly.

In the back are 2 Band Saws, a Drill Press, a Drum Sander and a Scroll Saw.

The second room is also called “The Lathe Room,” since it has three wood lathes.



The back wall contains Bench Tools (Grinders, a Mortiser, and Small Belt/Disc Sander.)

Under the shelf are hand held power tools (routers, sanders, etc), and an air compressor.

In the center of the room are workbenches.



The wall opposite the lathes has hand tools and work-in-progress bins.



The third room is for painting and staining.

There is an enclosed spray booth with filtration for chemicals used in spray paints.



To keep dust away from freshly painted/stained surfaces, no sanding is permitted in this room.





The fourth room is the Wood Shop Annex.

It is located around the corner from the shop.

It is primarily used for storage of wood and supplies, but is also used for work on large projects.
