Please do the following:

1 Fill out the information below. (For a couple, include both names and email addresses.

4 Return this complete package (this page, two signed copies of the Release Forms and one signed copy of the Shop Rules) along with a \$20 check (For a couple, \$25) made out to Association of Woodcrafters. Put it all in an envelope and campus mail it to Bob Bradus GV-326 TNC. Make sure you put my email rbradus@gmail.com into your contacts so that my future emails do not go into your spam.

5 On receipt of the package you will be sent an email from me asking you to make an appointment with our shop manager, Tom Mertz at 301-755-1799. He will introduce you to the shop, and then give you the shop entrance code.

SHOP RULES**

SAFETY IS THE HIGHEST PRIORITY OF THE WORKSHOP

It is REQUIRED that another person be present in the shop when a member uses the miter saw or any stationary tool. A non-member who has signed the Riderwood Association of Woodcrafters Woodshop Release form may accompany a member in order to meet this requirement.

Members and guests must put the dates and times of their entry and exit in the logbook at the door. They should strive to keep the shop clean of sawdust, chips and debris. Any damage to power or hand tools is to be reported to the shop manager promptly

When working in the Annex, the door must be left open.

All tools donated to the shop become the property of the Association of Woodcrafters.

Members may retain ownership of small hand tools if they are kept in a labeled toolbox, or one of the lockers. The Association of Woodcrafters is not responsible for the security of personally owned tools.

Members may borrow tools from the shop provided that a similar tool remains in the shop. Borrowed tools must be signed out and returned promptly, no later than one week.

Members acknowledge that there are risks involved in using both power and hand tools and they must accept personal liability for their own safety. Members not familiar with power tools are expected to ask for assistance in using them properly and safely.

Door combination must not be given to non-members.

Using noisy tools is restricted to the hours of 9 AM to 9 PM

All table saws, miter saws, etc. are not alike. Members are expected to be knowledgeable about the specific tools in the shop, and if not to ask for assistance. This is also to prevent damage to the tool, possibly rendering it unsafe.

By signing this document, a member acknowledges that he/she has read and agrees with it, accepts responsibility for following safe practices and is fully responsible for his/her own safety.
