Where, When and What to donate:

Small items: If your donation fits in a shopping cart, there are 2 options:

Every Tuesday - 9:30am-11:30am at the Treasure Chest (address above)

Monthly collections: 2nd Tuesday of each month 9:30am-11:30am in MST, TNC, and LSC lobbies.

***Do not bring Large Items / Furniture / TVs to store or lobby!**

Call the Treasure Chest at **301-572-8434** to arrange for a volunteer to visit your apartment to identify and tag acceptable items. General Services provides free pick-up.

(NOTE: Mobility devices - Wheelchairs, walkers, etc. will be donated to Wheels of the World. Call General Services at 301-572-8355 for free pick-up.)

ACCEPTABLE Items (in good clean condition)

No scratched, soiled, stained, broken or inoperable items!

- Jewelry (costume and fine)
- New / like new linens, table, bed, towels, decorator pillows
- Glasses, stems (no metal trim, sets of 4), coffee cups, mugs
- Dishes, no metal trim (sets of 4 or more)
- Silver, stainless flatware, kitchen utensils
- Cookware, Pyrex, Corning, etc.
- Small kitchen appliances
- Knick knacks, décor items, baskets
- Radios, portable CD, DVD players
- Artwork, framed mirrors, picture frames
- Lamps (no halogen)
- Plant stands, pots, vases, small garden tools
- Artificial flowers and plants
- Puzzles, games, toys
- Cards, gift bags, wrapping paper
- Purses, scarves, hats, gloves
- Vacuum cleaners
- Luggage
- Auto accessories, small hand tools
- Pet supplies (no food)
- Office supplies
- Storage bins, large and small with lids
- Trash cans (clean, like new)
- All seasonal decorations
- Tables and Chairs*
- Sofas 72" or under *
- Power Recliners*
- Chairs (not soft or "sat out") *
- Dressers with or without mirrors 60" or less *
- Chest of drawers 72" or less *
- Smart, flat screen TVs, 2023 or later with remote*

UNACCEPTABLE Items

- Clothing – Call General Services (301-572-8355) for free pick-up.
- Books, CDs, DVDs – try donating to campus libraries.
- Medical Equipment
- Dishes, cups, saucers with metal trim
- Anything made of ivory
- Humidifiers, air purifiers
- Boom boxes, large speakers, record players
- Computers, printers, monitors
- Unframed mirrors with wall holder clips
- Beds, sofa beds, mattresses, bed pillows
- Food, insecticides, cleaners
- Curtains, curtain rods, area rugs, carpets
- Wired ceiling lights / fans, wall lights
- Exercise bikes
- Stuffed animals
- Filing cabinets
- Shelves attached to walls
- All desks over 42" long
- Sofas over 72" long
- China cabinets
- Entertainment cabinets
- Hexagonal tables
