- **"Turn on Zoom" / "Turn off Zoom"** — Toggles the system screen magnifier.
- **"Turn on Spoken Content" / "Turn on Speak Selection"** — Enables spoken text controls.
- **"Turn on AssistiveTouch" / "Turn off AssistiveTouch"**

Core Touch Gestures

1-Finger Gestures (Basic Navigation)

- **Tap / Drag:** Explores the screen and speaks the item under your finger.
- **Swipe Right:** Moves focus to the next item.
- **Swipe Left:** Moves focus to the previous item.
- **Double-Tap:** Activates the selected item.
- **Split-Tap:** Alternative to double-tap—touch and hold an item with one finger, then tap anywhere with a second finger.

- **Swipe Up / Down:** Increments or decrements values (sliders, pickers) or navigates based on the current Rotor selection.

2-Finger Gestures (System & Media Controls)

- **Single Tap:** Pauses or resumes speech.
- **Double-Tap ("Magic Tap"):** Answers/ends calls, plays/pauses media, or starts/stops a timer.
- **Swipe Up:** Reads the entire screen from top to bottom.
- **Swipe Down:** Reads continuously from the currently focused item.
- **2-Finger Scrub (Z-Gesture):** Swipe two fingers back and forth quickly across the screen to dismiss alerts, go back a screen, or close popups.

3-Finger Gestures (Scrolling & System Toggles)

- **Swipe Up / Down:** Scrolls down or up by one full page.
- **Swipe Left / Right:** Scrolls right or left (pages in Home screen, apps).
- **Double-Tap:** Mutes or unmutes VoiceOver speech.

- **Triple-Tap:** Toggles Screen Curtain on/off (blacks out the screen while keeping VoiceOver fully functional for privacy and battery saving).

4-Finger Gestures (Structural Landmarks)

- **Tap near Top:** Moves focus to the very first item on the page.
- **Tap near Bottom:** Moves focus to the very last item on the page.
- **Swipe Left / Right:** Switches directly to the next or previous active application.
